Updates on NZ Navigator and news about a series of workshops being held around the country between July and September.

Continued growth within the community sector



A total of 710 organisations have registered with NZ Navigator since the tool launched, with 72 assessments completed between January and April 2015.

A snapshot analysis in April 2015 showed that 77% of visitors to NZ Navigator were new which demonstrates the website continues to be appealing and relevant to groups within the community sector.

Collective Impact

NZ Navigator is a wonderful example of many organisations working together to make a bigger difference. Part of that story is the way that the governance of NZ Navigator is a joint effort between the community partners and the Department of Internal Affairs.

Each year the Institute of Public Administration New Zealand (IPANZ) celebrates excellence in the Public Service sector and this year NZ Navigator has been nominated in the Collective Impact category of the IPANZ Awards. This nomination is a great acknowledgement of the value of collaboration.

The awards are announced towards the end of July. We will be sure to update you on the outcome.

NZ Navigator hits the road

Presentations are planned across the country between July and September this year and will be focused on local capability builders and other key organisations that are trusted conduits to information. The workshops will profile the latest developments with NZ Navigator and provide a practical demonstration of its functions and capabilities.

We hope that the organisations who attend will then be well placed to promote NZ Navigator within their networks and also support other groups to utilise it.



The workshops are a collaborative venture between NZ Navigator and DIA Charities Services. Participants will also hear about the new

reporting standards for registered charities and how these changes can be a catalyst for achieving better governance. The workshops will provide a great opportunity for local organisations that work in community development to get together and share news and ideas.
